



Eastmark Neighborhood Park Guidelines

At Eastmark, all roads lead to your neighborhood park. Thoughtfully weaving neighborhoods together, Eastmark parks spark interaction. As stewards of the community, residents play an important part in preserving the parks and ensuring the safety of these shared neighborhood assets. The following Eastmark Neighborhood Park Guidelines are in place to support residents' enjoyment of the parks.

- Daily park hours: Sunrise to 10 p.m.
- Parks are open to children and persons of all ages.
- The supervision of children is the responsibility of parents or guardians.
- Neighborhood parks are available to all residents and their guests at all times. Parks cannot be reserved.
- All parks are drug free zones.
- Glass containers are not permitted.
- Pets must be leashed at all times. Owners are responsible for cleaning up after pet(s) at all times.
- Disfiguring, vandalizing, or the removal of any park amenities or other harmful activities is not permitted.
- Driving motorized vehicles in the park or other non-designated areas is not permitted.
- Roller skates, roller blades, bicycles, skateboards, and hover boards are permitted on cement pathways only.
- Hitting, driving, chipping, or putting of golf balls or similar activities is not permitted.
- Music and noise must be kept at respectful levels.
- Litter and recyclables are to be disposed of in appropriate receptacles.
- Bounce houses or other inflatable units are not permitted.
- Advertising or soliciting of goods and services in, or adjacent to parks, retention basins or recreational facilities is not permitted.
- Sales of food, beverages, or other items is not permitted.
- Use caution around fire pits. Objects such as rocks and related debris can cause harm, including explosions. Do not add foreign objects to fire pits.
